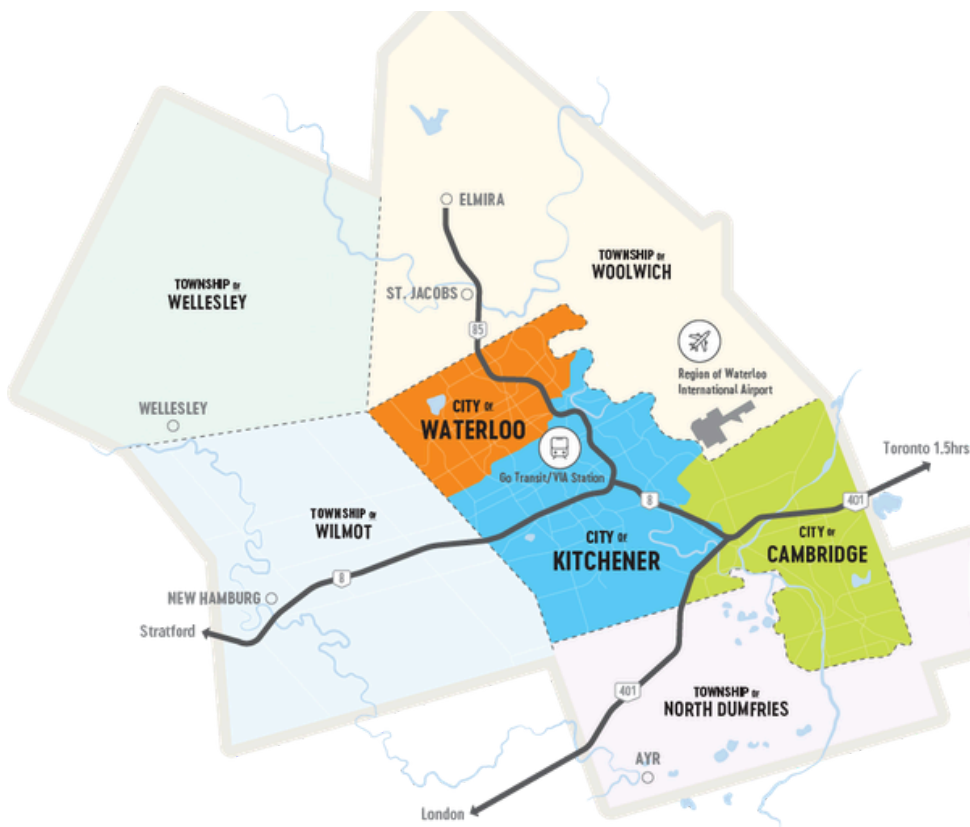


# Waterloo Region | Easy Access by Air, Road and Rail



## Getting to Waterloo Region:

Toronto: 97 km / 60 mi	Niagara: 119 km / 74 mi
Kingston: 343 km / 213 mi	Stratford: 59 km / 37 mi
Ottawa: 479 km / 298 mi	Buffalo: 169 km / 105 mi
Montreal: 622 km / 386 mi	Detroit: 288 km / 179 mi



**Three vibrant cities** – Waterloo Region is made up of Cambridge, Kitchener, and Waterloo, offering the amenities of a larger urban centre with the ease and accessibility of a mid-sized destination.

**One hour from Toronto** – Conveniently located just one hour west of Toronto and the Greater Toronto Area.

**Close to Canada–U.S. border crossings** – Approximately 1.5–2 hours to Windsor–Detroit, Sarnia–Port Huron, and Niagara–Buffalo, making travel convenient for both Canadian and U.S. delegates.



## By Air

Waterloo Region and the surrounding area are serviced by the Region of Waterloo International Airport (YKF), with daily service to Calgary provided by Westjet Airlines.

### **Air Canada Complimentary Shuttle Service (YYZ - YKF):**

- Complimentary luxury 36-seat motor coach service between Toronto Pearson International Airport (YYZ) and Region of Waterloo International Airport (YKF).
- 10 Shuttle departures daily between YYZ and YKF.



## By Rail

VIA Rail offers daily service from Toronto's Union Station. The local train station is located in the northeast corner of downtown Kitchener.

Go Transit provides daily service between Waterloo Region and Toronto's Union Station. The Go Train runs 10 times per day in each direction.
